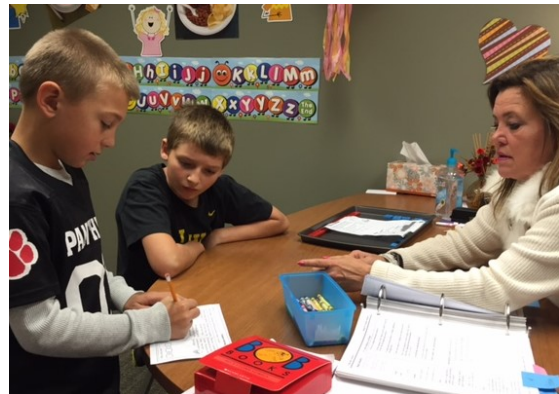

Who Am I Helping?

The time, intensity and duration of intervention needs to be based on each child's unique needs, this typically cannot be done in a traditional school day.

- Older struggling readers (past 3rd grade) with significant reading deficiencies may require up to 2 or more hours of intense systematic intervention per day, 5 days a week for 2 years.
- 1 in 6 children has a Learning Difference.
- 1 in 10 children have ADHD.
- 1 in 68 children has an Autism Spectrum Disorder.
- Up to 1 in 5 students in classrooms today have a form of Dyslexia.

The Purpose of TLC is to provide students who learn differently with the supplemental, research-based intervention, and support needed to achieve academic success.
